**CITYBUS TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS ON ROUTE CHANGES**

LAFAYETTE, IN, June 4 - CityBus will hold two public hearings to discuss changes to routes 1B and 4B and to let community members offer feedback. These hearings will take place on Wednesday, June 12 and Thursday, July 13.

The proposed changes to the Salisbury (1B) and Purdue West (4B) routes, effective August 2019, are part of CityBus's 2019-2025 Strategic Plan. CityBus began implementing this plan in January with later weekday service on routes 2A and 2B and a change to route 9.

CityBus's new routes will improve schedule reliability and expand coverage, with two-way service to parts of Sagamore Parkway and Klondike Road as well as new service to Cumberland Avenue. The proposed changes will also provide safer, more convenient access to Meijer.
