CITYBUS FARE COLLECTION TO RESUME ON MAY 4

LAFAYETTE, IN, April 28 - CityBus will collect fares again starting on Monday, May 4.

The transit system has modified the CityBus Center lobby to protect staff and encourage social distancing. CityBus will open the lobby to the public for fare purchase on Wednesday, April 29.

The lobby's capacity will be limited to 10 people, and passengers can only be in the building to buy bus passes.
